- Clinical trials are regulated by the FDA to ensure treatments are safe for humans. Our technology is ready to begin official FDA approved human clinical trials within 24 months of reaching the first fundraising goal of \$10 million.

The Ora Lee Foundation has established collaborations with oncologists, surgeons, navigators of the FDA approval process, and the Atlanta Technology Development Center (a technology incubator funded by the state of Georgia). We are ready to begin human trials. Funding is currently our only barrier to starting human trials.
